TIBCS has no legal recourse, it is only in the power of TIBCS to suspend or revoke a Member's membership. At the discretion of the TIBCS Board, complaints may be forwarded to the TICA Feline Welfare committee. By filing a formal dispute with TIBCS, you agree to abide by the findings of the hearing body.
